It looks a lot like a diary. But I've already got a diary.

You could use these as diary pages, but I don't - as I already have a diary for planning, I use these more for writing notes about things which have happened which are worth remembering, praying about and using to encourage others (and myself!)

What is the aim of doing this?

Mission to Work's aim is summed up in this key scripture, 1 Peter 4:11 - *"If you serve, you should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen."*

This week we considered the value in knowing God's mind and his will for us, and why this is not easy. We don't control God or even study him as if he were predictable and we could get our heads around him. Instead we have to worship, offering ourselves in sacrifice, and in return God transforms us, renewing our minds so that we can know what he wants us to do.

Next week we'll look at how we can apply what God has shown and given us personally into our relationships with other people. We can expect this to transform the quality of our life and work, and for God to become visible to others through loving relationships. It's where all the theory becomes real!
