### What are Mission to Work day notes?

### What is the aim of doing this?

Mission to Work's aim is summed up in this key scripture, 1 Peter 4:11 - *"If you serve, you should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen."*

This week we looked at what glory means, how and why we need to recognise God, and how this helps us and the church to grow. When we praise, we deepen relationships, and when we show others that we praise someone, we make that person more visible.

So the final challenge of "Mission to Work" is this - now that we know how much God loves us and has already equipped us for work, service and love, how much will we credit God in front of our colleagues, by what we do and say? Are we ready for God to use us, and for people to see that God is real, working in us?
